

UEFA EURO 2016: Only five days left to get your accreditation for the Fan Zone

If you are a journalist or a photographer, you only have five days left to apply for accreditation to the City of Paris to be able to enter the Eiffel Tour Fan Zone at the Champs de Mars.

The Eiffel Tour Fan Zone will be the nerve center of the hosting for UEFA EURO 2016: an exceptional, festive and popular place, where all games of competition will be broadcasted on a giant screen and where nearly 92.000 Parisians and visitors will be able to enjoy free activities.

The system provides podiums, cameras, and photographers, as well as a parking area for SNG vehicles. The Eiffel Tour Zone is also equipped with a 600 square meters media centre with a team of people dedicated to accompany you and guide you, a working room, a press conference room and a relaxation area.

If you have been accredited, you can come and collect your pass in the media centre of the Fan Zone from June 10th. Your accreditation will be nominative and available for the entire duration of UEFA EURO 2016.

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
