

Only 100 days to UEFA EURO 2016: Paris gives the big wheel a fresh look

From tonight and 100 days before UEFA EURO 2016, the City of Paris dresses the big wheel on place de la Concorde to the colors of the 24 countries that participate in the event. This photographic exhibition will be visible from this Friday and until the end of the competition.

From June 10 to July 10, 2016, Paris will have the honor of hosting UEFA EURO 2016, with nine other French cities, among which Saint Denis, its privileged partner. This will be an opportunity for the French capital to assert its identity of open, smart, sustainable, and creative city.



100 days before the competition, the city has decided to celebrate the 24 participating countries, as well as their faithful supporters through a photographic exhibition installed on the big wheel on place de la Concorde.

In order to fly high the colors of these countries, 24 photographic portraits will be placed on the gondolas of this emblematic attraction. Their installation will take place tonight and tomorrow, and they will be visible from Friday until the end of the competition.
