The City of Paris accordingly set up this foosball event for seniors and children in partnership with the association Tatane, whose Chairman is former football pro-player Vikash Dhorasoo.

This tournament enabled elders from retirement homes and children from day care centres to play side-by-side in mixed teams on cardboard-made foosballs.

After 8 events in retirement homes from different Parisian arrondissements, the final match will be held next Wednesday, promising once more exciting moments of joy for the players.

Moreover, Paris began to work on new plans for senior for the years 2017 to 2021 by developing different actions in which inter-generational bonds will have a central place.
