This year, the plot is focused on sport values on the occasion of UEFA EURO 2016. The players will have the opportunity to discover 15 arrondissements of Paris in an unusual way (3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>) as well as the suburban cities of Aubervilliers and Saint-Denis.

For this new edition, 50 paths were created, accessible for all and available in French and English, for people with reduced mobility, wannabe detectives and experts.

The diversity of the paths will be the occasion for the players to discover Paris and its many sites dedicated to sport. Sports associations will animate the paths and present activities to discover new sports disciplines.
