Around 07:00 p.m. today, the millionth visitor has crossed the gates of the Eiffel Tower Fan Zone before the kick off of the semi-final Portugal – Wales.

On the occasion of UEFA EURO 2016, the City of Paris welcomes Europe and the football world for a month. From June 10th to July 10th, Paris welcomes passionate visitors from all over the world to share the same fervour together!

The Champ-de-Mars welcomes the Eiffel Tower Fan Zone, central place of Parisian festivities. It provides all Parisians and visitors of all age with the possibility to live an extraordinary, festive and friendly experience around football.

Since its opening on June 9th, the Eiffel Tower Fan Zone brings happiness to French and visitors coming to celebrate their love for football in a friendly way. It continues beating records for attendance especially for the French team's games, with more than 90,000 visitors during the France – Switzerland game on June 19th and during the round-of-sixteen last June 26th against Ireland.
